A donation of \$5 per child is requested to help cover the cost of materials and snacks.

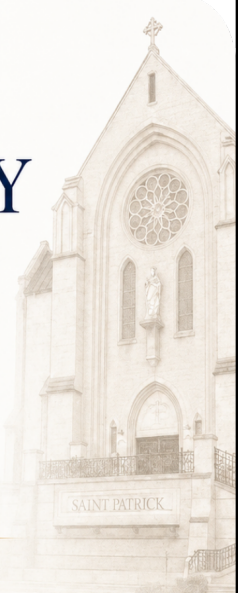
